


DETAILS

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 29

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 30 Côte Rôtie

- Delight in a post-lunch tour and tasting at another Côte Rôtie producer
- Check into **Fac & Spera Hotel et Spa** located in the center of the quaint village, Tain L'Hermitage, owned by one of the biggest names in Rhone winemaking: Michel Chapoutier.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 31 Tain L'Hermitage, Hermitage

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Your day starts with a visit to **Domaine Paul Jaboulet Ainé**, one of the biggest names in the northern Rhone and a producer of the world-renown La Chapelle, where you will experience a special tasting dubbed 'The Stars'.
- Savor a delicious multi-course lunch at Domaine Paul Jaboulet Ainé's **Vineum**, situated at the foot of the iconic **Hermitage hill.**
- Continue your exploration of this famous part of the northern Rhone with a tour and tasting at **Domaine Ferraton Père & Fils** where you will indulge in the estate's finest wines.
- Revel in a relaxed evening, discovering the local culinary delights on your own terms.



FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 1st Southern Rhone: Avignon, Vinsobres

- Breakfast at Hotel; Check out of Hotel
- Today you will be whisked to **Avignon,** where the Palais de Papes (Palace of the Popes), a world UNESCO site, majestically sits on the Rhone River.
- Your first visit in the southern Rhone Valley will be done en route at **Domaine Saint Vincent,** located in the former convent of Saint Cèsaire de Nyones, in the quaint village of Vinsobres, a southern Rhone wine Cru.
- Satiate your palate at a local winery estate for lunch
- Check in to Hotel Cloitre Saint Louis Avignon, a 16th century building rich in history with a mix of traditional and contemporary décor, located in the center of Avignon with views of the river. Here you'll luxuriate in your surroundings over the next three mornings/evenings.
- Spend an evening at your own pace, exploring the local foods of the Southern Rhone Valley.



SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Gigondas, Tavel

- Be sure to bring your appetite as you will indulge in a wine luncheon at the Michelin rated **Le Comptoir de la Mere Germaine** restaurant.
- Refresh your tasting palate with the regal rosés of Tavel at Château d'Aqueria, where the noble terroir has crafted the quintessential style of Tavel rosé, long deemed the most prestigious estate in this southern Cru.
- Indulge in a leisurely evening, exploring regional culinary delights on your own.



SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 3

- A glorious morning with free time to explore the Pont d'Avignon and Palais des Papes, cultural and historical sites that will forever be imbedded in your memory.
- You will team up once again at VinsRhone for a private tasting class in the center of Avignon, where you will continue to elevate your Rhone Valley palate.
